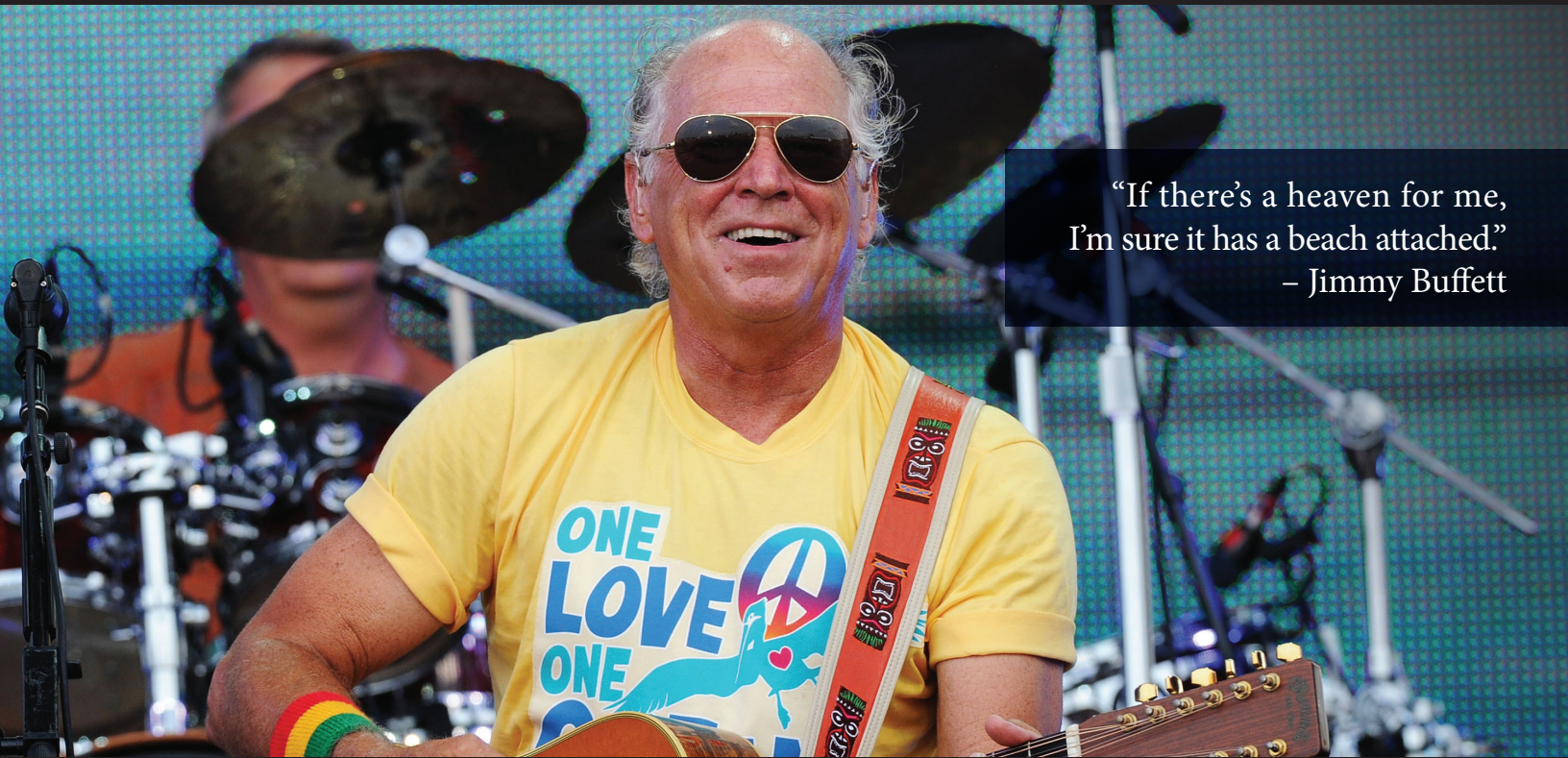


Mississippi's Own Son of a Son of a Sailor Sets out on His Final Adventure.
